



THE REBUILDING

Several countries were immediate in their response in offering help in both urgent relief and the commencement of the building process. As always New Zealand and Australia were prompt in their perennial and ongoing support. However, none were more appropriately forthcoming as the Tahitian teams of builders whose pre-cut houses were being landed at Niue within 10 days after the cyclone.

About 40 such houses were to be constructed and the spirit and energy with which this was carried out has strengthened the resolve of the people of Niue to rebuild a new future.
